

# "T" IS FOR TRINITY

**Key Theme** God is three persons in one: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

**Key Verse** "Hear O Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD is one."  
DEUTERONOMY 6:4

**Lesson Summary** Though abstract for children, the concept of the Trinity is foundational to biblical Christianity. All the attributes of God, all the facets of His character must be put in the context of His "three-in-oneness". Therefore, this lesson introduces the Trinity at a basic level: There is only one God; the one God is three distinct persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit; and each person of God is fully God.

- Is there only one God, or more than one God?
- What is another name for God the Son? [Jesus]
- Is Jesus God? Is the Holy Spirit God?

## HOW SHOULD I ACT TOWARD GOD?

**Memorize** Deuteronomy 6:4.

**Responding to God** Because there is only one true God, how should we act toward Him? Look up some answers in the following verses: Deuteronomy 5:6-9a; Deuteronomy 6:5. How can you show God that you love Him "with all your heart and with all your soul, and with all your strength"? Make a list of three things you will do this week to demonstrate your love for God.

**Play** with *The ABC's of God* flash-cards you've created so far. Have someone hold up a card and say the letter and word. You tell them the meaning of the word. OR have someone read the meaning of the word, and you say the word they are defining.
