### ***The Lord God of Truth***



**SCRIPTURE:** Genesis 2:16-17; Genesis 3:1-5;  
Numbers 23:19; John 8:44; 1 Peter 2:9; 2 Corinthians 10:5

**MEMORY VERSE:** (Choose one of the following)

*Psalm 18:30— As for God, his way is perfect; the word of the LORD is flawless. He is a shield for all who take refuge in him.*

*Proverbs 30:5— Every word of God is flawless; he is a shield to those who take refuge in him.*

*Numbers 23:19— God is not a man, that he should lie, nor a son of man, that he should change his mind. Does he speak and then not act? Does he promise and not fulfill?*

#### **KEY THEMES:**

- God does not lie, every word of His proves true; He will fulfill all His promises because He is a God of truth.
- Satan is a liar.
- God will lead us in the truth if we trust in Him.

#### **IDEAS FOR PARENT FOLLOW-UP:**

1. Help your child memorize the memory verse.
2. Read the above scriptures, and think about the key themes.
3. *Deuteronomy 6:6, 7* instructs us, “*These words...shall be upon your hearts... Talk of them when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise.*” Therefore, in the everyday circumstances of life, when you are driving in the car, eating a meal, performing a chore or any of the multitude of activities in which parents and children are engaged together, talk about Jehovah-El Emeth. For example: In a particular situation, you may remind your child of an appropriate promise of God and state that every word of God is true because God is Jehovah El-Emeth. Encourage your child to trust in that promise because God is trustworthy.
4. Pray that your child would believe the word of God and trust in His promises.
5. Encourage your child to complete his take home sheet.
